We hope you feel the same thrill we do to learn that, last year on average, **880 new disciples came to** faith in Christ every week, and engaged in one of 39 new fellowships planted each week.

These new believers make serious, often costly decisions to follow Christ. Many go on to be equipped as disciple-makers. Some are developing as Christ-like leaders, through our leadership training.

We faced plenty of challenges this past year. We had reports of disciple-makers being ridiculed, beaten, stoned, or thrown into prison by those who oppose Christ. Yet persecution seems to only strengthen their resolve and the commitment of their friends and co-workers.

In certain regions, opposition means using our 'underground model' for training. In addition, a growing number of disciple-makers and church planters are being equipped to start a small business, thanks to our "What's in Your Hand" training model. This gives them an acceptable identity in challenging settings, and a way to support their families.





# FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

#### Source of All International Funds



This fiscal year, \$1,956,713 came from non-U.S. sources in support of Global Disciples affiliated programs.

## Non-western Churches Contribution

To encourage local sustainability, we require the local cluster of churches to supply at least 51% of resources needed the first year to launch a training program. The remaining percentage is contributed by Global Disciples as "seed funds." Over three years, local funding increases while Global Disciples' contribution decreases. The goal is full support from local sources by year 4. The church cluster contributes the equivalent of \$2,000 for every \$1,000 given in seed funds (a 2:1 ratio).


This fiscal year, these local churches invested the equivalent of \$1,534,983. Currently, 616 programs are in years 1-3 of training, and use seed funds to supplement support from their local cluster of churches.

Additionally, in 2017, **139 training** programs **reached local sustainability.** Of the 1,202 active programs, **52%** (**or 620** programs) **are now fully sustained by local sources.** 

### **Global Disciples Foundations**

A National Foundation is a group of business leaders who invest resources, time, and experience to support the efforts of Global Disciples in their own nation. The long-term goal is to reach a point where a National Foundation covers all annual and ongoing costs within their country.

This fiscal year, the five National Foundations outside the US provided the equivalent of \$421,730 to the work of Global Disciples.




