Hallelujah! Revelation 19:1	Seek the Lord today for wisdom, justice, stability, and integrity in the governments of Central Africa, that His people would be free to live peaceful and godly lives. ## **Definitions**

Our Mission: To make it possible for clusters of churches to multiply Christ-like disciples and locally-sustainable fellowships among least-reached people.

**Our Vision:** To see that every person has an opportunity to choose and follow Jesus Christ

The Circle of Significance: A circle of nations within south and east Asia which includes nearly 55% of the world's population on 15% of its land mass. Within this circle live 99% of the world's Hindus, 98% of its Buddhists and over 50% of its Muslims, but only 4.2% of the world's Evangelical Christians.

**Directors Training:** Training provided by Global Disciples to prepare Program Directors to lead one of three training phases (Discipleship-mission, Small Business Development, Leadership Development).

Facilitator: A Global Disciples staff person who trains and coaches Program Directors and who promotes the vision and mission of Global Disciples in their territory, helping clusters of churches develop their training programs to reach least-reached people.

**Program Directors:** A person selected and supported by a cluster of churches to be trained by Global to lead an affiliated training program. He/She also participates in mentoring, submitting prayer items, and attending Annual Equipping Events.

**Training Program:** Trainings that equip disciple-makers and church planters in discipleship-mission, small business development, and leadership development.
