**September 1** As we begin this month praying for our Southeast Africa region, let us pray for both physical and spiritual rain to bring nourishment and new life. (Jeremiah 14:22; John 4:14)

**September 2** We give thanks to God for using Global Disciples to expand His kingdom and multiply disciples in Southeast Africa! Please pray for unwavering integrity in everything we do. (2 Corinthians 1:12)

**September 3** Niko leads our new Southeast Africa region of Malawi, Mozambique, and Zimbabwe. He asks us to pray for wisdom, grace, and guidance from the Holy Spirit in his role. (John 16:13-14)

**September 4** In Zimbabwe, *Mapostori* combines Christianity with tribal religion. Pray for a megaphone of God's truth to overcome this dangerous false doctrine. (2 Peter 2:1; Ephesians 4:25)

**September 5** Lulu has been faithfully serving the Southern Africa region as their prayer leader. Join her in praying for unity of purpose and harmony among staff as they carry out their work. (Ephesians 4:1-3)

**September 6** As we fast and pray this First Friday, we seek the Lord on behalf of those held captive by witchcraft and Islam in Southeast Africa. May they experience true freedom in Jesus! (John 8:34-36)

**September 7** Praise the LORD with Chui, one of our Facilitators, for the multiplication of church planters in Mozambique! Intercede for them as they labor for the Lord's harvest. (John 4:34-38)

**September 8** We praise God for 111 active church clusters in Malawi, Mozambique, and Zimbabwe! Pray for them to be strengthened and edified as they declare the Word of God. (Hebrews 13:7)

**September 9** In Malawi, 2.6 million of the Yao tribe are unreached with the Gospel. Pray for open doors and soft hearts in this Muslim people group typically opposed to evangelism. (Colossians 4:2-4)

**September 10** Plead with our Father for an end to the HIV/ AIDS epidemic in Southern Africa. We pray for truth to prevail over false teachings, and for mercy and healing for those who are sick. (Psalm 25:5-7)

**September 11** Knowing that one day, every knee will bow to Jesus, we bring Zimbabwe's leaders to Him today. We pray that Jesus would apprehend them for His purpose and glory. (Philippians 2:9-11; 3:12)

**September 12** Denis and Ivan are the newest facilitators in the Southeast Africa region. Pray that they would gain understanding and rely on the Holy Spirit for their roles and responsibilities. (Proverbs 2:1-8)

**September 13** Today, we intercede for those who have recently come to saving faith in Jesus in Southeast Africa. May they grow in faith and find fellowship and encouragement in the Body of Christ. (Colossians 1:9-11)

**September 14** In Northern Mozambique, over 2 million Macua people have chosen Allah or the spirits and ancestors as the focus of their worship. Pray for the Word of Life to be proclaimed to them. (1 John 1:1-3)

**September 15** Please pray for Andre Lesur, our Executive Director for GD Canada, as he is in Winnipeg today, preaching at Cities Church. For many lives to be challenged by the Word of God. (Hebrews 4:11-13)

**September 16** We love because God first loved us. Pray that our Southeast Africa staff and program directors would be known by their love for the least-reached among them. (I John 4:19-20)

**September 17** In Malawi, thousands of Gujarati Indians are seeking fulfillment in wealth through business/enterprise. Pray for our SBD programs to equip Christians to engage spiritually with them. (1 Corinthians 9:22)

**September 18** The 22,000 unreached Doma people of Zimbabwe isolate themselves from others which makes evangelism difficult. Pray for open hearts and a bold Christfollower to reach them. (Isaiah 65:1)

**September 19** Support Facilitators Videl, Perry, and Banga in prayer as they oversee program directors in Southeast Africa. Pray for relationships built on trust and for safety as they travel. (Luke 19:17)

**September 20** Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we recognize that apart from You, we can do nothing. Please remind our staff and teams to set aside time each day to spend in Your Word and in prayer. (John 15:4-5)

**September 21** Jesus me ama means "Jesus loves me" in Portuguese, the primary language of Mozambique. Sing a song of Jesus' loving care over the many children living in poverty and disease. (Matthew 19:13-15)

**September 22** In Zimbabwe, the true Gospel of Jesus is often distorted as people seek a quick fix to poverty. Pray for the Church to preach the whole Word of God and focus on eternal riches. (Matthew 19:16-24)

September 23 As worship leader trainings multiply in Southeast Africa, we pray that God uses the teaching to ignite a revival in churches, and to spur evangelism and outreach. (Acts 16:25-32)

**September 24** Pray with Debra for strength and wisdom in serving the Lord as Admin and Data Manager for Southern Africa. We praise God for her physical health and faithfulness. (2 Peter 1:3)

**September 25** It is now spring in Southern Africa, and rain is needed for the planting season. Pray that our Creator and Sustainer would provide for their needs and receive their thanksgiving. (Deuteronomy 11:13-15)

**September 26** Today and tomorrow the GD Canada Board and Staff have a 2 day retreat. For unity and wisdom for the year ahead for GDC. May the presence of the Lord be very close. (Psalm 133:1-3)

**September 27** Pray for a church-planting movement among Mozambique's 710,000 Makonde people, who worship their ancestors instead of their Savior. (2 Timothy 1:9-10)
