November 1 November begins with our Global Disciples day of prayer and fasting. Please join us as we intercede for both unreached people and the Christians among them in the Middle East and North Africa. (1 Timothy 2:1-6)

November 2 Our regional prayer leaders have gathered in a Middle East location for a time of training and team-building through November 8. Pray for the Holy Spirit's presence and power. (1 Corinthians 12:7-14)

November 3 Today our clocks Fall Back an hour. Remember our Muslim-background brothers and sisters in prayer as they worship secretly. Pray for them to find support and connection with other believers. (Ecclesiastes 4:9-12)

November 4 Intercede for "frontier people groups"—those with less than 0.1% Christian witness and no active Jesus movement. Pray for more cross-cultural pioneers to carry the Gospel to them. (Jonah 4:10-11)

November 5 Join a Global Disciples leader in prayer as he seeks to connect with the right people in a Middle Eastern city for a time of vision-casting. May God pave the way and open doors. (Psalm 32:8)

November 6 Tomorrow, our regional prayer leaders plan to engage in groundbreaking prayer in a spiritual stronghold. Pray for God's truth to be proclaimed and His presence to be undeniable. (Isaiah 40:3-5)

November 7 Early Church leader Augustine said, "Our hearts are restless until they find their rest in Thee." Pray that the unreached in Augustine's homeland of Algeria would find rest and salvation in Christ Jesus. (Psalm 62:1-2)

November 8 As more Muslims explore the web and social media, pray for them to discover Jesus in Bible-centered websites and Christian profiles. *Father, please move their hearts to pursue truth.* (John 14:6, 15-17)

November 9 Only 10% of Muslims know a Christian. Ask God to reveal His Son in dreams and visions and lead them to a Jesus-follower who can disciple them. (Joel 2:28-29)

November 10 *Īsā al-Masīh*—Jesus the Messiah—is one of the names of Jesus in the Quran. Ask Holy Spirit to quicken the hearts of disillusioned Muslims to seek and know Jesus as revealed in God's Word. (Luke 24:26-32)

November 11 On this Remembrance Day let us be thankful for the many privileges and freedoms we enjoy in Canada. Pray that He will turn the hearts of Kings to allow Arab believers freedom to share Jesus openly (2 Chronicles 20:5-6)

November 12 As we experience a staff transition in a North African country, ask God to bring forth and prepare His chosen person for this leadership role. (2 Timothy 2:15, 20-21)

November 13 Approximately two million Omani Arabs rely on Islam's works-based righteousness. Pray for Gospel-infused media, spiritual hunger, and courage to place their trust in Christ alone. (Romans 1:16-17)

November 14 The border to one of our region's neighboring countries has closed. Seek the Lord with us for innovative ways to work with disciples on the ground in this closed country. (1 Chronicles 16:8-11)

November 15 Jesus calls all people to Himself. Pray for all Israel to look upon the One they have pierced. May prophecies in Scripture come alive to them and turn their hearts to their Messiah. (Zechariah 12:10; John 12:30-36)

November 16 Pray for discipleship training plans in two North African countries. Specifically, we are seeking discernment for timing and translation work. May God's plan come to fruition! (Proverbs 16:3)

November 17 Though over 89 million people are unreached in Iran, Joshuaproject.net reports almost 20% annual evangelical growth rate! Praise God for rapidly growing His kingdom here! (Philippians 1:12-14)

November 18 Pray for a courageous, Spirit-filled Body of Christ in Saudi Arabia, home to the Muslim holy city of Mecca. *Jesus, please reveal Yourself as the majestic King of Kings to Saudi Muslims.* (Revelation 19:11-16)

November 19 *Lord of the Harvest, please call forth workers to carry the Gospel to persons of peace among more than four million Berbers in the mountains and villages of Morocco and Algeria.* (Luke 10:1-9)

November 20 Intercede for Iraqi Christ-followers who risk their lives to follow Jesus. Pray for strength and mercy as they face their persecutors, and for divine deliverance from all evil. (Psalm 97:9-12)

November 21 Bedouins comprise approximately 1/10th of the Muslim population in the Middle East and North Africa. Their nomadic life makes evangelization difficult. Pray for open doors. (Revelation 3:7-8)

November 22 In one unnamed Middle Eastern country, we have already trained more than 160 committed disciples of Jesus. Pray these seeds would take root in fertile ground and multiply. (Isaiah 61:11)

November 23 *Father God, today we bring to You the children in the Middle East and North Africa who have never heard the Good News of Jesus. Please protect their minds and make a way for them to hear the Gospel.* (Psalm 103:13-18)

November 24 "Blessed are the poor in spirit." In prayer, carry the refugees, the marginalized, and the oppressed in Muslim-dominated countries to Jesus, that they might be adopted into God's family. (Matthew 5:1-10)

November 25 In the Middle East and North Africa, Islam is the national and cultural identity. Pray for courage for Muslims to seek and follow Jesus despite pressure and persecution from family and society. (Matthew 5:10-12)

November 26 As Christ-followers serve and work in Muslim homes and communities, we pray for these ambassadors to be the aroma of Christ, discerning in their interactions, and known by their love. (2 Corinthians 2:14-15)

November 27 One of our Restricted Areas leaders asks us to pray for the right connections in three specific North African countries. We know God is working and wants to expand His kingdom there. (Isaiah 66:18-20)

November 28 Though Islam is the state religion of Jordan, their constitution does permit free exercise of religion. Pray for continued freedom for Christians and protection from discrimination. (Psalm 86:2)

November 29 The Magi who brought gifts to Jesus were likely ancestors of modern-day Kurds. *Jesus, please draw the Kurdish people to Yourself, that they might give their lives to You for eternity.* (Matthew 2:1-11)

November 30 Pray for God's presence and transformation next month during the planned discipleship training and equipping event in this unnamed North African country. *May Your will be done!* (Matthew 6:9-10)
