

January 1 As we start this new year, let us renew our commitment to pray faithfully each day for God to extend His hand to rescue the third of the world living in spiritual darkness. (Colossians 1:13-14)

January 2 We praise God for allowing us to partner with 115 church clusters in Southern Africa! Pray for their 150+ training programs to continue multiplying disciples and fellowships among the least-reached. (Philemon 1:4-7)

January 3 On the first Friday each month, we join our staff around the world to fast and pray. Many of them live in areas hostile to Christianity. Please pray for their protection, provision, and encouragement. (Acts 14:21-22)

January 4 Islam is a way of life for over 100,000 Swahili Muslims in Southern Africa. Ask the Holy Spirit to awaken their hearts and minds to a biblical worldview with Christ as Lord and King. (Ephesians 1:18-21)

January 5 Pray with Malama, our Southern Africa Regional Coordinator, for wisdom, knowledge, and discernment in leading his team and in preparing for six Annual Equipping Events over the next three months. (Proverbs 2:1-8)

January 6 Epiphany celebrates the visit of the Magi. Just as the star drew these men to Jesus, the Christ child, pray that God will draw all who seek the truth to Jesus, the risen Savior. (John 4:23-24)

January 7 Join Lulu, Southern Africa Prayer Leader, as she prays for burdens to be lifted from program directors, healing over sickness, restoration in families, and the removal of barriers in their spiritual walk. (Matthew 9:35-36)

January 8 About 7,000 Comorian people from Madagascar and Eswatini follow Islam mixed with the occult, and they are resistant to evangelism. Intercede for workers with a vision to reach them. (Matthew 9:37-38)

January 9 Deborah serves as our Southern Africa Administrative Assistant and Data Manager. Pray with her for wisdom, unity, and effective teamwork in this rapidly growing region. (1 Peter 4:10-11)

January 10 In Zambia and South Africa, 83,000 Gujarati Hindus are unreached with the Gospel. Pray for spiritual

hunger to grow among them and for disciples of Jesus to engage with them. (Matthew 5:6)

January 11 Locate the countries of Botswana, Eswatini (or Swaziland), Lesotho, Namibia, South Africa, and Zambia on a map. Ask our Father to meet their physical needs in growing economic hardship. (1 Samuel 2:7-8)

January 12 Pray for our Executive Director, Andre Lesur, as he ministers the Word of God today at Numa Church at 10am PST. Numa Church is near White Rock, BC, and is one of our supporting churches. Pray for lead pastors Nic & Sarah. (Psalm 37:23-24)

January 13 Ask God to protect our Southern African brothers and sisters as they plant churches in communities where people need to be freed from the bondage of witchcraft and the occult. (Psalm 91:9-10)

January 14 Abba, Father, we ask for Your mercy and healing for girls and young women in Southern Africa who are suffering from the devastating effects of the HIV/AIDS epidemic. Please give them hope. (Psalm 107:19-21)

January 15 Lemba, our Southern Africa Head Facilitator, asks us to pray for trained program directors to conduct their programs, leading to life transformation and spiritual fruit. (John

January 16 Pray with Southern Africa Facilitator Seretse for unity of purpose among church clusters and program directors to fulfill the vision to see lost souls redeemed by the Gospel of Jesus. (Philippians 2:1-11)

January 17 Spirit of God, please fill Southern African Christfollowers with love for Your Word and lead them to spiritual maturity. Give them the mind of Christ as they represent Him to the world. (1 Corinthians 2:6-16)

January 18 It is the summer growing season in Southern Africa, where maize (corn) is their primary crop. Ask the Lord of the Harvest to grant them a successful planting season both physically and spiritually. (Psalm 65:9-11)

January 19 Pray for godly leaders in Botswana to initiate improvements in infrastructure. May they receive wisdom from above to improve the way of life for their people. (James 3:17)

January 20 Our GDC Board will be meeting from 3:00pm PST. We give thanks for our new Board member, Joseph, who will take over as Treasurer next July. Two more Board members are needed for this coming year. Pray for wisdom as they meet and plan for 2025.. (Acts 2:42-43)

January 21 An Annual Equipping Event begins today in Lusaka, Zambia. Holy Spirit, our Comforter and Counselor, please minister to the hearts of program directors and renew their spirits. (Psalm 51:10)

January 22 Praise God for the Zambia Foundation—business leaders and professionals who support local trainings. Pray with Malama for more financial partners and new Foundations in more countries in this region. (Nehemiah 12:46-47)

January 23 Nearly 40% of Namibia's youth are unemployed. Pray for Small Business Development training to begin in Namibia, so that they can discover both financial and spiritual hope. (Psalm 121:1-2)

January 24 Our adversary prowls around, looking for ways to destroy the covenant of marriage. Pray for our brothers and sisters in Southern Africa for restored and strengthened marriages. (1 Peter 5:8-9)

January 25 Pray for peace and prosperity for the people of Lesotho and Eswatini as they struggle with food insecurity and poverty. King Jesus, please turn the hearts of their kings to bless their people. (Proverbs 21:1)

January 26 Islam is the cultural identity of the Yao people in Zambia. Pray for a disciple-making movement within this people group. May they discover spiritual riches in Christ. (2 Corinthians 8:9)

January 27 Please join us this evening on the Zoom Prayer Call (see top left). We will have with us a staff member live from the Southern Africa region to give us the latest prayer needs and lead us in a time of prayer together. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

January 28 Intercede with our Facilitator Godfrey for the unreached of Katanga in southern Democratic Republic of Congo. Pray for church planters with God's heart for them. (John 17:20, 25-26)

January 29 As you lift up our Southern Africa team and program directors, pray that they would be rooted and established in love and filled with the fullness of God. To Him be the glory! (Ephesians 3:14-19)

January 30 We ask our God to continue His redemptive work in the remote and isolated areas of Botswana and Lesotho. We know He is willing that none should perish—that all come to saving faith in Jesus! (2 Peter 3:8-9)

January 31 Our Southern Africa Facilitator Sipho asks us to pray with him for God's grace as they complete five more Annual Equipping disciples Events in February and March. May they not grow weary in doing good. (Galatians 6:9)
